

Program Evaluation Results

- * Universally high program outcomes
- * Stabilization of alcohol consumption consistent across the spectrum of severity



What's Next

696 ER diversions from MAP sites and 31 ER visits between December 2010 - March 2013

- * Analysis of OACIS/OICHI records
 - * Number of ED visits
 - * Ambulance use and diagnoses of trauma
 - * Seizures or intoxication at presentation.
 - * Hospital admissions and lengths of stay
 - * Blood test markers of alcohol use.

Analysis of police records for 6 months pre/post admission

* One recorded incarceration between April 2010 - March 2013
